(3) Experience in teaching English, preferably at the university level (certification in English language education such as TESOL is desirable) (4) Master's degree or PhD in the humanities, such as linguistics, literature, cultural studies or education; or in the social sciences, such as economics, sociology, or political science (5) Ability to give lectures and seminars in the above fields in English, in addition to English language courses (6) Passion for education, character and expertise appropriate for university faculty (7) Able to live in Nagano City or nearby area during employment
Method of selection	Applicants will be screened in accordance with the University of Nagano's regulations. 1st Selection: Examination of documents. 2nd Selection: Those applicants selected for an interview and teaching demonstration will be invited starting from early October. * Please understand that transportation costs for the interview are covered by the applicant.
