Admission	<p>After receiving the application documents, International Office returns to Partner University an admission letter, JW202 form, and a handbook for admitted exchange students.</p> <p>After the admission, the International Student Affairs Center will be responsible for assisting prospective incoming students studying at CUC.</p>
Language Requirement	<p>TOEFL (iBT 80 or above/ ITP 550 or above), IELTS (6.0 or above), English CEFR (B2 or above), or Duolingo English Test (110 or above).</p> <p>*Students whose native language is English or from institutions in which English is the primary language of instruction do not need to submit TOEFL score.</p> <p>For the students who want to take the courses in Chinese, recommended Chinese Language test score is HSK 5 (recommended)</p>
Faculties/Schools Available to Exchange Students	All courses are open to Exchange Students. For further information, please refer to https://en.cuc.edu.cn/
Workload per Semester	Maximum 24 Credits (1 Credit = 16 Study Hours)
Accommodation Options	<p>CUC may NOT be able to provide On-campus dormitory housing for all exchange students due to limited availability. Although CUC will reserve accommodation for exchange students in advance, dormitories and room types are randomly assigned and cannot be changed.</p> <p>Students opting for living off campus need to notice the International Student Affairs Center in advance.</p>
Tuition	Students on direct exchange pay tuition at their home university.

Insurance	International Students are required to stay medically insured throughout their period of study. Students can pay the insurance fee for Accident Insurance and Medical Insurance in China on registration days. For insurance coverage and other information, please visit http://www.lxbx.net/en/ .
Visa Information	Students apply for X visa in Chinese Embassy with the documents provided by CUC. Students who hold an "X" visa need to apply for residence permit at the International Student Affairs Center within 30 days of their arrival in China. If you fail to apply for it after the deadline, you will be regarded as illegal residence and will be fined heavily. Students please register at the International Student Affairs Center according to the date notified by CUC after entering in China.

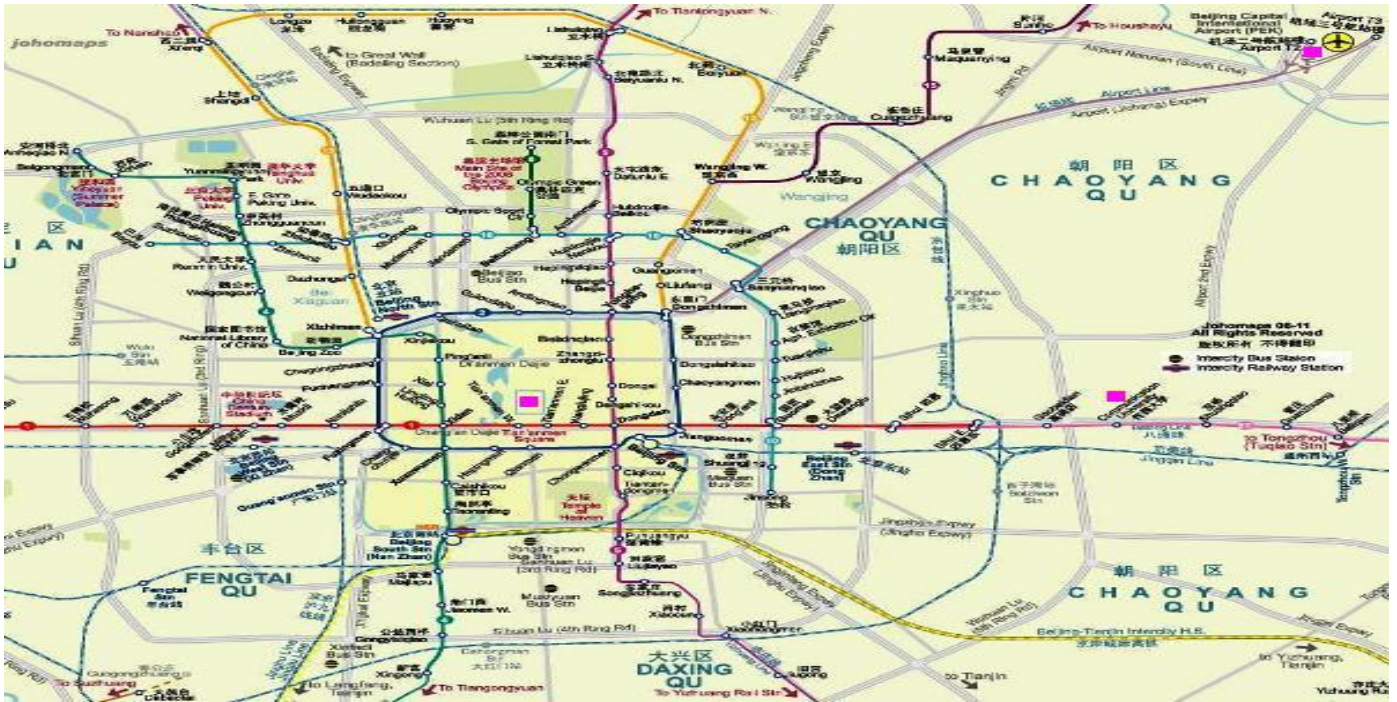
